The number of lectures is subject to change at the discretion of the Organizing committee of the Conference depending on the number of submitted applications. Working languages: Russian, English.

**Applications and conference abstracts** shall be sent to the Organizing committee of the Conference no later than on **October 15, 2010**.

**Application** should be filled in accordance with *Appendix 1* requirements.

**Conference abstracts** in RTF-format shall meet the following criteria: maximum 2 printed pages (including brief annotation: 3-5 sentences); margins: 20 mm; line spacing: 1; font size: 12; footnotes – bottom-page, font size: 10 (*Appendix 2*).

**Application forms and conference abstracts should be sent at [kazan2010conf@mail.ru](mailto:kazan2010conf@mail.ru)** (by two separate files; "Subject" field should contain name of educational institution). Application forms and conference abstracts will be accepted only in electronic format and only at the abovementioned address.

Selection of students and postgraduates whose applications and conference abstracts meet the announced formatting and deadline criteria will be done on a competitive basis. Selection criteria have to do mainly with the conformity of submitted materials to the conference topic and formal requirements, as well as with originality and autonomy of content.

Conference book shall be out of print by the conference opening date. The organizational fee of 10 EUR is to be paid upon the receipt of official invitation and notification of acceptance of abstracts for publication. List of selected students and postgraduates will be available at [www.sno-law.ksu.ru](http://www.sno-law.ksu.ru) by **October 31, 2010**. The Organizing Committee will send you the official invitation with the indication of bank details for payment of the organizational fee. Conference participants who have paid the organizational fee will receive their conference books at registration desks on November 26, 2010. On-site presence is required. No conference materials (including conference book) will be sent by mail.

Travel, accommodation costs and per diem allowances are to be paid by sending institutions and/or conference participants. Coffee-breaks will be organized on conference days. Hotel reservations will be made by the Organizing Committee at the request of conference participants.
